Why are you interested in joining the Tech Crew?

Lights: You need to be able to assist with the set-up of lights. You are responsible to set up light scenes prior to events, and operate lights during Sunday Services, Christmas Program, and any other programs throughout the year. You also need to have a basic understanding of lights and its program.

ProPresenter/PowerPoint: You need to ensure that ProPresenter on the computer is set up prior to service. You also need to be able to troubleshoot any issues that arise, by having a basic understanding of ProPresenter and Mac OS and their functions.

Sound: To run sound we ask that you have a working knowledge of sound equipment, be able to assist with sound checks for bands before services, be able to troubleshoot problems on the spot, and have an ear for live music. We ask also that you understand or are willing to learn sound equipment on stage and how they affect different instrumentation. Finally, have an understanding of what contemporary worship sounds like and what the vision of the worship leaders is. Must understudy with a sound tech crewmember for two months.

Video Camera- Be able to man a camera during Sunday Services, aid in filming events at Bethel Family Min., have a creative eye, knowledge of how their camera works, basic understanding of lighting, and audio capture (capturing live audio).

Video Editing (Post): Have a knowledge of editing software, knowledge of motion software, be able to edit videos for Sunday Services, Christmas Programs, and any other programs or events throughout the year, this include any voice over capture that is needed after live shooting.

Photography: Aid in photographing events and services at Bethel Family, have a creative eye, knowledge of how their camera works, and a basic understanding of lighting in regards to photography.

Blanket Expectations:

Have a servant's heart: As the tech crew we are here to serve and aid our leaders, follow directions that are given to you, and submitting under the proper chain of command.

Be attentive: Whether you are operating lights or focusing on Pastor Benny with a camera on Sunday service, always make sure you know what's happening, what's happening next and staying on your task.

Show Up: Be able to help out on Sundays and other events throughout the year. If you're not able to make it, please give us at least two weeks' notice if you are on schedule for a planned event. We know that life can happen, so if you get some

lemons, please just let us know as soon you know, so we can plan accordingly. Remember we are a team and we need to keep each other up to date.

Teamwork: What's gonna work? TEAMWORK. As tech crew no matter what you are doing, sound, lights, camera work, etc., we are working together to worship God, and aid in others worshipping God.

Punctuality: We know that sometimes getting to places on time can be challenging, however many tech functions require punctuality or being early. So if time is an issue make sure you can plan ahead and be early.
